

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH W7/18, BURTON BRADSTOCK AND W1/25, BRIDPORT


DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along Footpaths W7/18 and W1/25 from grid reference SY 464 902 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 474 897 (point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 1200 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation 03 June 2024 for a period of 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This closure is required for health and safety reasons due to severe erosion and danger from cliff falls.

The alternative route will be; From point A head North/Northeast for approximately 200 metres along Marsh Barn road until you meet footpath W7/17, point E, at SY 466 904. Follow W7/17 east until you reach point D at SY 478 899. At this point head Southeast along footpath W7/17 through the holiday park until you meet point C at SY 480 896. From this point follow footpath W7/18 West until you reach point B at SY 474 897.
