

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD, WEST BAY FOR BONFIRE ON THE BEACH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along STATION ROAD, WEST BAY between its junction with West Bay Road and The West Bay public house, a distance of approximately 90 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 26 October 2024 between 1630 and 2300 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the activity will be completed by 2300 on 26 October 2024.

This Notice is required to facilitate the arrangements in connection with the Bonfire on the Beach event.

There will be no signed alternative route for traffic on this occasion.
