

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST MICHAEL'S LANE, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ST MICHAEL'S LANE, BRIDPORT between its junction with Tannery Road and Kernow Pantry, a distance of 65 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 21 October 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 November 2024.

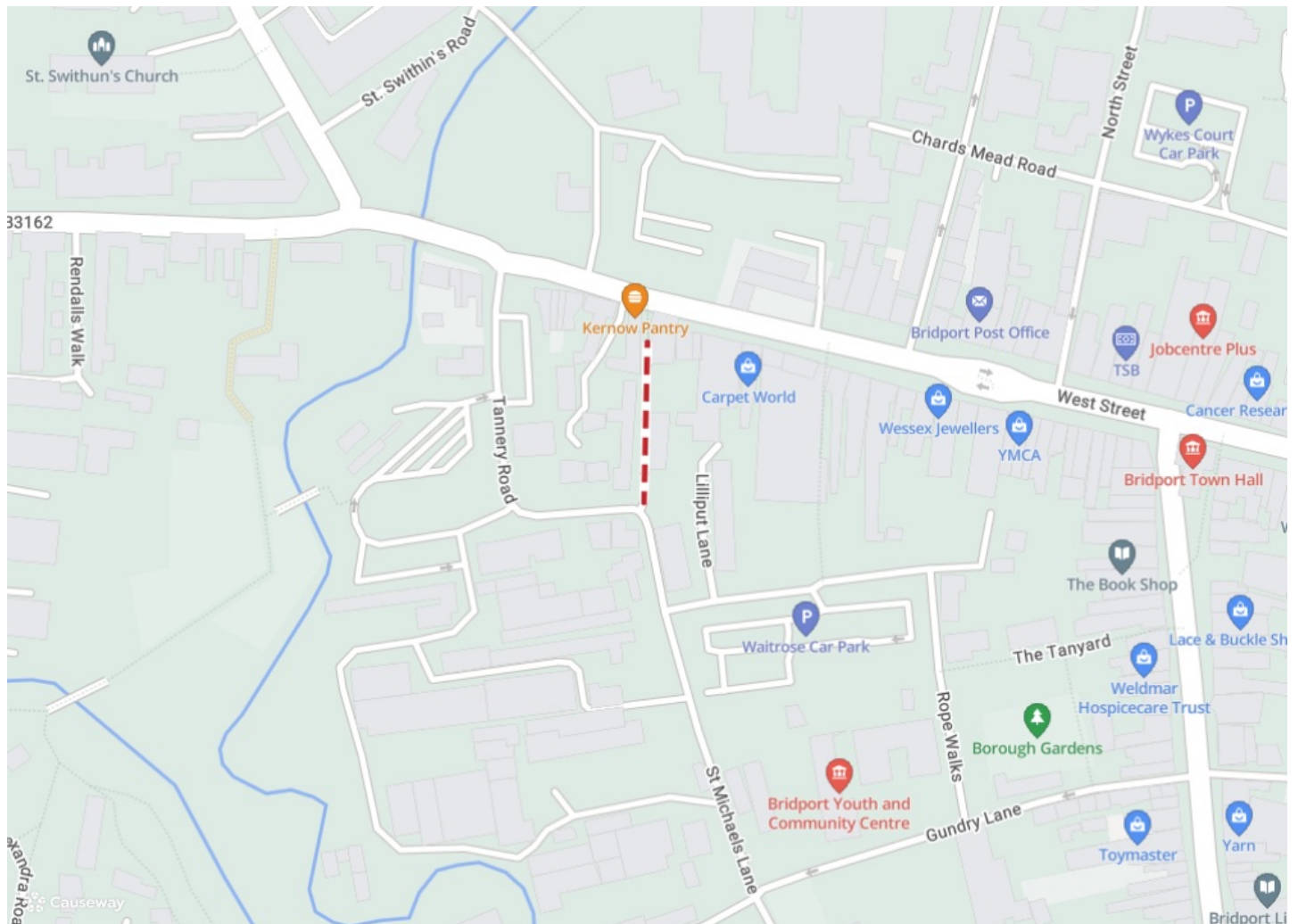
**This Order will enable National Grid to replace high voltage underground cables.**
