## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF ST SWITHIN'S ROAD, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 28 October 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 November 2024.

## This Order will enable TUC Ltd, safe access to excavate for duct installation.


The effect of the Order is as follows:

- [1] To impose a parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent parking on the highway along ST SWITHIN'S ROAD, BRIDPORT between its junction with B3162 and its junction with Fulbrooks Close, a distance of approximately 280 metres.
- [2] To impose a clearway as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting on the highway along ST SWITHIN'S ROAD, BRIDPORT between its junction with B3162 and its junction with Fulbrooks Close, a distance of approximately 280 metres.
