

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B3162, SALWAY ASH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along B3162, SALWAY ASH between its junction with C18 and the entrance to Bide Yer, a distance of approximately 1210 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0930 and 1530 on 11 December 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 13 December 2024.

**This Notice will enable National Grid safe access to replace decayed electricity pole.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3162 - B3163 - A3066
