

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EAST STREET, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along EAST STREET, BRIDPORT between its junction with King Street and A J Wakeley & Sons, a distance of approximately 120 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 2100 and 0500 on 18 November 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 November 2024.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to carry out duct overlay.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A35 - B3157
