

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KING STREET, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along KING STREET, BRIDPORT between its junction with B3162 and 2, King Street, a distance of approximately 25 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 06 January 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 January 2025.

This Notice will enable South Coast Traffic Management safe access to provide safe working area for scaffolding and urgent works to a property.

On this occasion there will be no specified alternative route for diverted traffic.
