

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WALDITCH ROAD, WALDITCH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along WALDITCH ROAD, WALDITCH between its junction with Lower Walditch Lane and 6, The Green, a distance of approximately 185 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0930 and 1530 on 13 January 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 January 2025.

This Notice will enable National Grid safe access to change LV electricity pole.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Lower Walditch Lane
