

## TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED LIMIT, B3157, BRIDPORT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. The effect of the Notice will be to impose a temporary 30mph speed limit upon B3157, BRIDPORT, between the entrance to the sewage treatment works and a point approximately 130 metres north, at such times and to such extent as indicated by the traffic signs. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It comes into effect between 0930 and 1530 on 30 March 2025 and remain in force for 5 days. However, it is anticipated that the speed limit will remain in force until 1530 on 30 March 2025.
